- b) We will try and use carboard boxes and duct tape to create larger bins for July event, to make it easier for customers to look through the clothes. If this is a disaster, banana boxes are the fallback plan. If concept is good, will look into creating large reusable bins (Stewardship Committee).
- c) Tookie will put announcement in Next Door and PI List on July 4th about dates/times for drop-off.
- d) Linda will update the Church Kiosk and use input from the July Star as provided by Rev Will.
- e) Add Ice Cream Social from 11am to 1pm.

4) General Communication Topics:

a) Karin is attaching the marked-up rev 2 draft of the *Communications Policy* for review by the team; goal is to ratify at next Assembly meeting on August 28th.

- b) Joanne noted that one of the Peaks Island Tours includes our recent history of disaffiliation with UMC and association with UCC and UUA. Interesting!
- c) SJTF Bulletin Board needs an eye-catching header. Linda to ask Liz Rollins if she can create one with her beautiful calligraphy.
- d) There once was a road sign with directions to the Church; can we create a new one and where should it go?
