## Updates

**Social Justice:** Timmi Seller's egg painting workshops raised over \$900 to send to Doctors Without Borders for their work in Ukraine. It was suggested that the Community Arts and Play advisory board start by clarifying what kinds of activities they believe should (or should not) fall under their mandate.
